2020-2021 HMMS Dress Code Policy

School Expectation: Harns Marsh Middle School is a uniform school. Many professionals wear uniforms in the workplace. The HMMS uniform code supports and enhances a positive environment where learning is a priority.

TOPS: short or long-sleeved polo shirts with 2 or 3 buttons

- Solid in any color one small logo permitted
- Solid color undershirts (long or short sleeved) may be worn under the polo
- · Shirts will be tucked in at all times
- HMMS Spirit/Club shirts may be worn on Fridays
- OneTeamOneFamily shirts may be worn on Mondays

BOTTOMS: uniform long pants, shorts, skirts, and capris

- Navy or khaki/tan
- Worn at the waist and of the correct size
- · Long pants should not be tucked in shoes/socks or gathered in any way
- Length of skirts/shorts must be at or below the knee in standing position

OTHER

- ✓ BELTS: plain, solid color and unadorned with no oversized buckles
- ✓ SHOES: closed toe and closed heel shoes must be worn at all times
- ✓ HAIR & MAKE-UP: be of natural color and not distracting to the learning environment
- ✓ JEWELRY: piercings are acceptable in the ear(s) only. Necklaces & chains must remain tucked inside of the student's shirt. No jewelry that may pose a safety concern.
- ✓ HATS & SUNGLASSES: permitted to be worn for protection during outdoor activities
- ✓ JACKETS/HOODIES: only permitted to be work before and after school, not in the building during school hours
- ✓ Gym clothes may be worn only during P.E. class and during athletic events
- Masks must be either a medical mask or a solid color cloth mask

NOT PERMITTED

- Jeans (denim of any color)
- ☑ Cargo shorts/pants, "Joggers", carpenter pants, low rise bottoms, or "hip huggers".
- Oversized or tight clothing, torn or frayed clothing, ornamental stitching
- Any item or apparel that promotes or depicts gangs, guns, violence, racism, illegal activity, or the use of alcohol, drugs, tobacco
- ☑ Visible tattoos, simulated tattoos, or fake/temporary tattoos
- Sweatbands, bandanas, headbands and flags

Students must be in uniform compliance at all times while on campus Violation of this uniform policy may result in disciplinary action
